

Tornado Emergency Procedures

Signal for Notification

A tornado alert is signaled by an intermittent ringing of the alarm.

Procedure After Notification

Upon receiving notification of a tornado alert, each class or group on the first floor is to proceed outside their classroom into the inner hall, sit along the wall (everyone), and leave room to walk down the middle of the hall. Following are the exceptions:

Rooms 101 and 102 are to proceed to the cafeteria

Room 201 and 202 are to proceed to the hallway outside of room 105 and 106.

All elementary students and elementary faculty in the auditorium are to proceed to the place they occupy during every tornado drill. All other students and faculty are to proceed into the hallway on the north side of auditorium. Stay away from the lobby of the auditorium.

All students and faculty in the field house, locker rooms, and pool are to exit into the first floor corridor and bathrooms on the east side of the field house.

Students and faculty on the second floor are to leave their rooms and proceed as follows:

Rooms 205 through 212 are to proceed downstairs to the cafeteria and sit along the west wall. Stay away from the windows on the east wall.

Rooms 213-227 are to proceed down NE stairs to E-W hallway on the first floor.

Rooms 230 through 251 are to use stairs C and proceed downstairs to N-S hallway on the first floor.

Rooms 252-255 use stairs D and proceed downstairs to the E-W hallway on the first floor by the north side of the girls locker room.

Rooms 1,3,6,9 proceed to the hallway outside room 6.

Room 10 should enter the cafeteria and all students and faculty should remain there. Move to the inner wall and sit along the wall.

All students in the art and technology rooms proceed through the corridor into the elevator area.

All Clear Signal

An all-clear signal will consist of six (6) short rings of the school bell.
