

## Request for Veteran's Preference

The University of Northern Iowa provides for veteran's preference to qualified veterans as required by Iowa Code Chapter 35C.

To request veteran's preference, you must provide official documentation for military service or proof of Disabled Veteran status to Human Resource Services. Official documentation for military service is a DD214. Official documentation for Disabled Veteran status is a Veteran's Administration (V.A.) disability rating sheet and/or letter stating disability status from the V.A.

Please submit this form and the DD214 or V.A. Disability documentation to the University of Northern Iowa Human Resource Services office.

- If you are applying for Merit employment, your veteran's preference status will remain valid for the life of your Merit Employment application, which is one year from the date received. If your previous Merit application has expired and you submit a new application you will need to submit a new DD214 or contact us to pull your previous DD214.
- If you are applying for a Professional & Scientific (P&S) position, you will only need to submit your DD214 for the first P&S position for which you apply.
